

## Chinese Health Fair Report: 2014 “Lipid and Related Diseases”

On September 20, 2014, the 26<sup>th</sup> Annual Chinese Community Health Fair was held at the Culture Center of TECO. CADAH is one of the sponsoring organizations and CADAH Foundation supported the event with a \$1000 donation.

The main theme was “Lipid and Related Diseases.” The event performed free serum lipid screen for some 230 people in the Chinese community.

CADAH members, including Dr. Peter Chang (cardiology), Dr. Eugene Lai (neurology), and Dr. Peter Lin (vascular surgery), delivered speeches during the Education Workshop, which was attended by approximately 300

people. In addition, Dr. Stephen Chao, Dr. Lina Ching, Dr. Hsi-Sheng Chuang, Dr. Yvonne Kew, Dr. Robert Wang, and Dr. Chun Xie were kind to provide counseling to the Chinese community. The event closed with many people still lingering around to ask more questions to the panelists.

The organization committee appreciates the generosity of CADAH Foundation and the effort of CADAH volunteers. Hopefully there will be more CADAH members participating in the future Chinese Community Health Fairs.

## CADAH Foundation: President's Letter

I would like to take this opportunity to give a succinct history of the genesis of our CADAH Foundation Board. I hope, both our life-time members and new members may find it interesting.

CADAH Board was initially established under the visionary leadership of Dr. Chi Mao in 1993. When I served as the President of CADAH Board from 2000 to 2001, our board had first explored the logistics, pros and cons of the establishment of CADAH Foundation to serve as a non-profit corporation. However, the aforementioned proposal was not approved as yet, at that time, in concern of undermining the financial robustness of our CADAH Board itself. Luckily, under the continued hard work and dedication of all our CADAH members, the financial foundation of CADAH has strengthened enough over the subsequent years so as to warrant the re-evaluation of the establishment of CADAH Foundation in the latter part of 2003. Accordingly, under the leadership of Dr. Edward Chan and his CADAH Board (2002-2003), the letter of incorporation to form a non-profit CADAH Foundation, so as to be exempted from taxation under Section 501 (c)(3) of Internal Revenue Code, was signed on 6/8/2003. Subsequently, an amount of \$5000 was then transferred from CADAH Board to CADAH Foundation to serve as basic operational funds on 8/25/2003.

Our first CADAH Foundation President was Dr. Maria Tan who served with distinction from 8/6/2003 to 4/11/2004. Since then, both CADAH Board and CADAH Foundation have mutually strengthened financially. I am glad to inform our CADAH members that CADAH Foundation has successfully increased our reserve to over \$100,000. We have increased our initial "seed money" to more than 20-fold within eleven years. All such successes would not have been possible without the two important elements. First, it would have to be the



unyielding support to our CADAH Chinese New Year Scholarship Gala by our fellow members, their families and friends. Second, none of these would have been possible without the unflappable dedication of both our CADAH Board and CADAH Foundation Board members in our formative years.

Looking into our promising future, I do see potential issues that may be divisive for CADAH. I do recall back when we first explored the feasibility of CADAH Foundation, our CADAH Board (2000-2001) had also explored the logistics, pros and cons of establishing a CADAH Political Action Committee (PAC). After thorough analysis with additional outside legal opinion, our CADAH Board has voted

unanimously against it. We felt that any Political Action Committee would be not only divisive, but also contrary to the "founding purpose and goal" of our apolitical professional organization as established in our original CADAH by-laws.

Subsequently, proposal for CADAH PAC was once again brought up for voting in our Annual General Assembly (AGA) on 4/23/2005 at which time the proposal was also overwhelmingly defeated. I would like to update CADAH that the suggestion for PAC was brought up again for discussion at the CADAH Foundation Board meeting on 3/23/14. Sensibly, the aforementioned proposal was defeated five to one. I feel confident to say that our CADAH organization and CADAH Foundation Board feel that CADAH has been very well represented by Harris County Medical Society (HCMS) and Texas Medical Association (TMA). We should just leave all the politics to the already well-funded and extremely efficient PAC of TMA. I wish you all have a wonderful holiday season. We are looking forward to a successful new year under the leadership of Dr. Susan Yang.

## CHINESE AMERICAN DOCTORS ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FORM

The Chinese American Doctors Association of Houston (CADAH) has been awarding scholarships to local medical and dental students for the past several years, approximately five each year. The amount of each scholarship has been between \$1,000-2,000. The scholarship recipients will be announced at the CADAH Annual General Assembly to be held in April 2015.

To qualify, an applicant must be EITHER:

1. A second, third or fourth year student of Chinese descent currently enrolled in an accredited medical or dental school located in the Houston/Galveston area.

OR

2. A child of a CADAH member who is currently enrolled in second, third or fourth year of an accredited medical or dental school located outside of the Greater Houston area.

\* Please note that past recipients of this scholarship are not eligible. Priority is generally given to upper level students.

Applicants must submit all of the following:

1. A completed application form.
2. A signed copy of the Certification of Chinese Descent on the last page of application.
3. A copy of the student's medical/dental school transcripts.
4. Two letters of recommendation from the student's college, graduate school or medical/dental school professors. These letters need to be in sealed envelopes with the professor's original signature across the sealed flap.
5. A one page personal statement.

\* As part of the scholarship award process, an interview will be scheduled with the Scholarship Committee in February 2015.

All documents must be postmarked on or before January 5, 2015.
